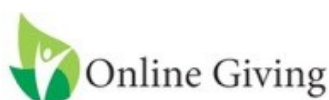
The Catholic Center will be donating alms to various charities in the area to assist the needy. We will no longer distribute the funds directly from the Catholic Center Office.

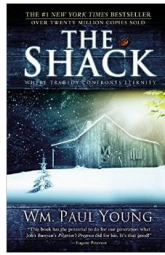

PARISH PILGRIMAGE

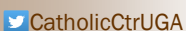
