Memorial Day, originally called Decoration Day, is a day of remembrance for those who have died in service of the United States of America. Memorial Day was borne out of the Civil War to honor our dead. It was officially proclaimed on May 5, 1868 by General John Logan, national commander of the Grand Army of the Republic. On the first Decoration Day, General James Garfield made a speech at Arlington National Cemetery, while participants decorated the graves of the Union and Confederate soldiers. The date of Decoration Day, as he called it, was chosen because it wasn't the anniversary of any particular battle.

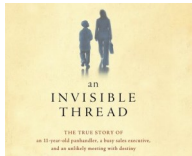
