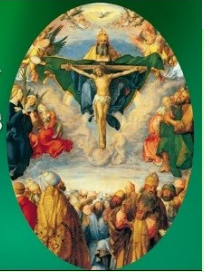

The History of All Saints & All Souls Days



All Saints' Day is a solemn holy day of the Catholic Church and is celebrated annually on **November 1st**. The day is dedicated to the saints of the Church, that is, all those who have attained heaven. It should not be confused with All Souls' Day, which is observed on **November 2nd**, and is dedicated to those who have died and not yet reached heaven.

Generally, All Saints' Day is a Catholic Holy Day of Obligation, meaning all Catholics are required to attend Mass on that day, unless they have an excellent excuse, such as serious illness.

In some places, such as the Philippines, graves can be painted and repaired by family members.

These celebrations often blur the distinction between All Saints' Day, which is properly dedicated to those who are in heaven, and All Souls' Day, on which prayers are offered for all those who have died, but have not yet reached heaven.

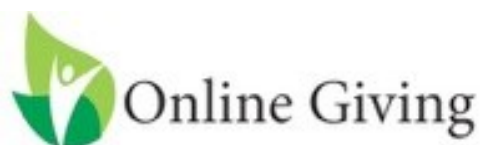
