WORKSHOP: A CATHOLIC LOOK AT WAR & GLOBAL CONFLICT

Justice and Peace Ministries would like to invite you to attend "A Catholic Look at War & Global Conflict." This workshop will be held on Saturday, April 28, at Transfiguration Catholic Church in Marietta, 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM.
