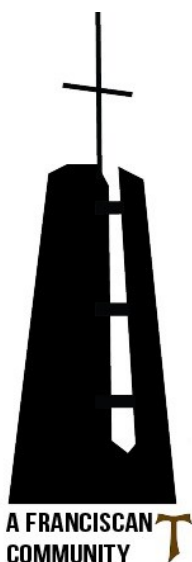

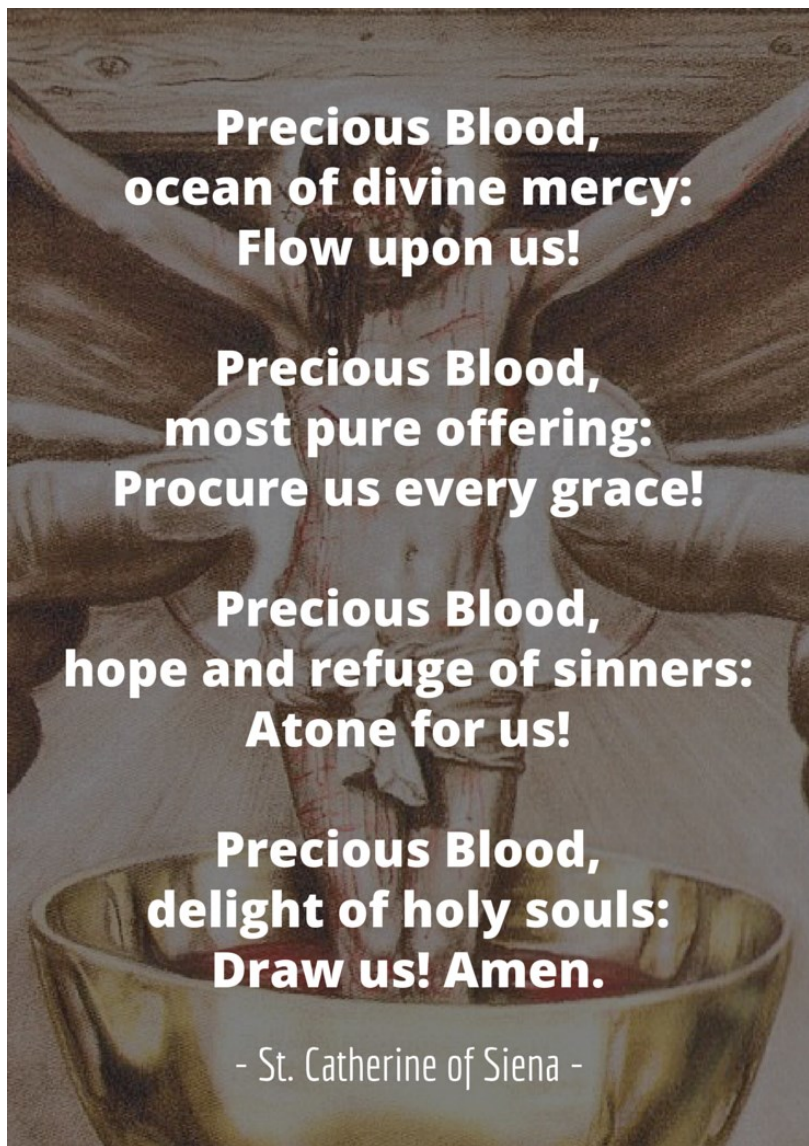
**MASS SCHEDULE NOTICE**

**RELIGIOUS ED FOR 2018-2019 SCHOOL YEAR**

Religious Education classes will begin Wednesday, August 29. The Catholic Center offers Religious Education and Sacramental Preparation for children and teens. The starting age for RE is Pre-K (4 years). Candidates for First Communion and Confirmation are required to have two consecutive years of RE/preparation in order to receive the sacrament. RE registration for the upcoming school year is open now. All students from Pre-K to Confirmation must have a completed application form. 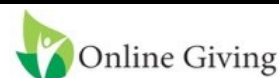
